### Friends with Feathers Program Friday, March 11th from 3:30-5:00pm

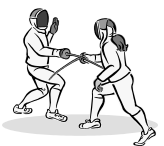

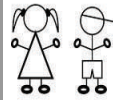
## Getting Paid to Talk, Making Money with Your Voice

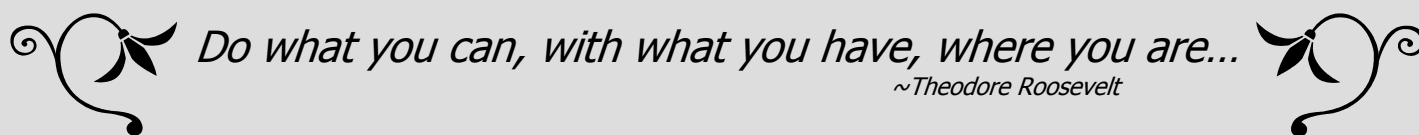
