### Tour of George Eastman House and Exhibits ~ April 28th

Designed by J. Foster and built between 1902-05, George Eastman House is a National Historic Landmark. The 35,000 sq ft Colonial Revival house contains 37 rooms, 13 baths and nine fireplaces and cost \$300,000 to build. A 14-month house restoration, completed in January 1990 at a cost of 1.7 million, was intended to present Eastman's house as a memorial to the man who lived there. A nationwide search resulted in the recovery of many of Eastman's belongings once thought lost or destroyed. On **April 28th**, come enjoy a tour of this historic home and exhibits which will feature Civil War in motion pictures. Lunch will be on your own at the Eastman House Café which serves delicious daily specials, soups, salad, sandwiches and melts. Bus transportation leaves the Center at 9:15am. 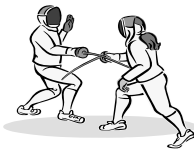

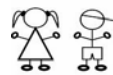

The 5-Day a week program, appropriate for children 4 or 5 years old (MUST BE 4 BY 12/1/11), is a kindergarten readiness program held Monday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. to Noon, beginning in September and running through June. The children will develop listening, fine motor, visual and social skills through fun experiences. **Early Pre-School AFTERNOON PROGRAM!**

This program, appropriate for 3 to 4 year olds (MUST BE 3 BY 12/1/11), is offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 12:30-2:30 p.m. Children begin their learning experience in a playful yet structured environment. Children will experience letter, number and name recognition. Sharing and positive interactions with other youngsters will be enhanced. They will have fun with music, storytime and gym time. **'Busy Bees' Toddler Playgroup**

**Lifeguard Training / Certification**

The purpose of the Lifeguarding course is to teach candidates the knowledge and skills needed to prevent and respond to aquatic emergencies. The course content and activities prepare candidates to recognize and respond quickly and effectively to emergencies and prevent drowning and injuries. This training program requires strenuous physical activity. To enroll in the Lifeguarding course, you must be at least 15 years old. To pass the Lifeguarding course, you must be able to demonstrate several requirements which can be listed upon request. Upon successful completion of the Lifeguarding course, each participant will receive an American Lifeguard Certification indicating Lifeguarding/First Aid, which is valid for 3 years and an American Lifeguarding Certification indicating CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer which is valid for 1 year. The course will take place on the following days: March 10th & 11th at Gillam-Grant from 6-9pm, 12th & 13th at the pool from 11:30am-5:30pm, 19th at the pool 2:30-8:30 pm & 20th at the pool from 11:30am-5:30pm.
